You’ll laugh and hide and read and draw

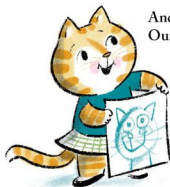
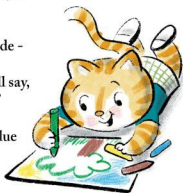
“And think of all the games you’ll play!
