Bats never sleep while they're flying or they would go batty.

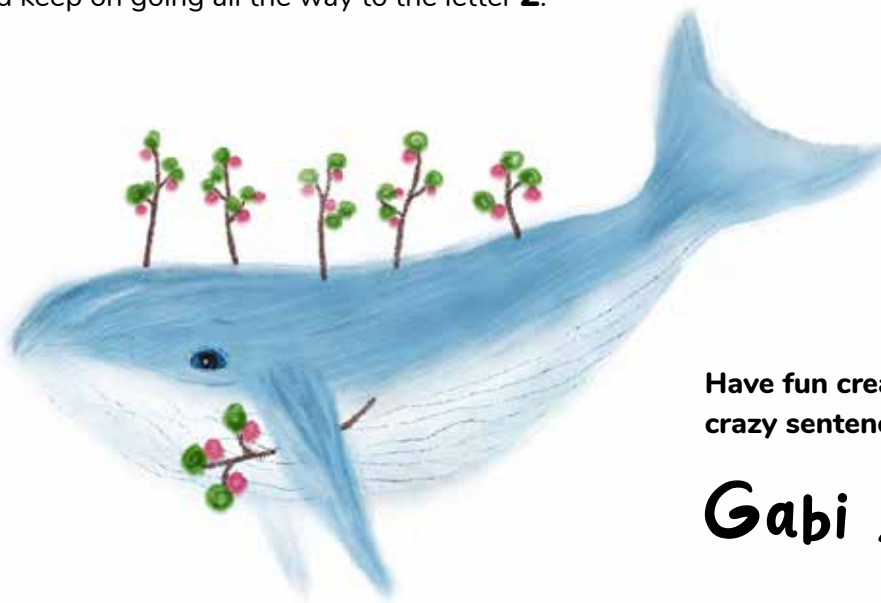
Now it's your turn
