6 FACTS ABOUT CHINESE DRAGONS:

Chinese dragons are made up of different animals. They have the head of a camel, the horns of a deer, the ears of an ox, the body of a snake, the scales of a carp, the paws of a tiger and the claws of an eagle.

The Dragon is one of the twelve animals on the Chinese Zodiac.

Chinese dragons symbolize luck and good fortune. They do good things like bring rain when there is a drought.

Chinese dragons live at the bottom of seas, rivers, lakes, or anywhere where there is water.

Emperors in ancient China were considered to be the sons of dragons. They wore robes with dragons embroidered on the front.

Chinese dragons don't have wings like western dragons do.
